

# Shawinigan Adds to Plant

**Rapide Blanc, La Tuque  
Get New Generators;  
84,500 h.p. Capacity**

Installation of two new hydro-electric generator units, recently completed for Shawinigan Water & Power, increase the power capacity of the system by 84,500 h.p., it has been announced by the company.

The new generators, which were installed at request of the federal power controller for additional power in the St. Maurice Valley, have been added to the capacity of the company's plant at Rapide Blanc and the jointly owned St. Maurice Power Corp. at La Tuque. The report also states new installations will be of considerable benefit to Quebec Power, a subsidiary of Shawinigan Water & Power, whose transmission system forms an integral part of the Shawinigan system.

Former capacities of the Rapide Blanc and La Tuque plants were 160,000 h.p. and 178,000 h.p. respectively, while total capacity of Shawinigan and its partly and wholly owned subsidiaries amounted to over 1.2 million h.p. All work done on the new installations was carried out by Shawinigan Engineering.
